

Terms and conditions

- When signing up to a challenge event, you agree to pay Peace Hospice Care the registration fee, and are committing to raise the sponsorship target, listed on the relevant web page.
- Registration fees for all challenge events are non-refundable and cannot be transferred to another event or product.
- You agree to organise fundraising activities as an independent supporter of Peace Hospice Care. You should therefore refer to raising money "in aid of" Peace Hospice Care, rather than on Peace Hospice Care's behalf.
- You agree that you shall comply with any instructions or guidance provided by Peace Hospice Care relating to your fundraising activity.
- You will be responsible for any costs, taxes or expenses incurred or arising in connection with your fundraising activity.
- You accept that any risks arising out of your fundraising activity are your responsibility, including liability for any injury or loss which may occur to you, your helpers or guests. You will therefore take all reasonable precautions to protect the health and safety of all those participating in, involved with or attending your activity.
- You will comply with any applicable laws and regulations relating to your fundraising activity, including obtaining any necessary licenses, consents or permissions e.g. if you are holding a raffle or lottery, or are proposing to sell alcohol.
- You acknowledge and accept that Peace Hospice Care's insurance policy will not cover your fundraising activities.

- You will not do anything that threatens Peace Hospice Care's reputation or name. If you do, Peace Hospice Care has the right to ask you to stop your fundraising activity immediately.
- You agree to pay all of the proceeds raised by your fundraising event to Peace Hospice Care as soon as possible after the event (and subject to any agreed timescale), and in accordance with Peace Hospice Care's instructions. You may not deduct any costs unless agreed in writing with Peace Hospice Care.
- You shall encourage donors and/or sponsors to make Gift Aid declarations where eligible, which may enable us to recover basic rate tax on such donations.
- Unless Peace Hospice Care has provided you with branded materials as a result of your registration, you may only use the Peace Hospice Care name and logo for your fundraising activities with our written permission, and in accordance with the Peace Hospice Care Guidelines. To apply for permission, you will need to let us know how you propose to use the Peace Hospice Care name and/or logo on your own materials by [contacting us](#), and provide us with examples and/or samples of such use if we request it.
- If you provide photographs or videos taken during your fundraising activity to Peace Hospice Care, you agree that these may be used by Peace Hospice Care for commercial and/or fundraising purposes. By sending these to us, you are also confirming that anyone featuring prominently in the photograph or video is aged 16 or over, and that they have consented to their image being used in this way.
- If you are under 18, you confirm that you have shown these terms and conditions to your parent/guardian, and they have agreed to accept responsibility for complying with these terms and conditions.
- You agree that the Peace Hospice Care can use the details that you have provided to discuss your fundraising activity and follow up on your progress.
